The Outside-the-Box Grant rewards creativity aimed at expanding students' understanding of their community and the world. An example of a funded grant is Jeff Platt's South Middle "Five-Star Leaders: Crisis at Little Rock" grant. Every 8th grade student studies materials provided by the Eisenhower Library that explores democratic leadership, constitutional concepts, and the process of consensus-based decision making. They then travel to the Library where they role play historical figures, analyze school desegregation issues, and participate in mock news conferences.
