APPLICATION DUE DATE: March 1, annually

This electronic application form can be completed and saved to your computer. Completed applications must be submitted to the senior counselor by March 1. A selection committee of Salina South High school faculty—consisting of the principal, a senior counselor, an attendance secretary, and two faculty members appointed by the principal—will determine the recipient. The committee will notify the Salina Education Foundation of the name of the chosen recipient no later than April 15.

ELIGIBILITY:

This scholarship shall be awarded annually to a Salina High School South graduate who will attend the University of Kansas. Furthermore, the recipient must exhibit grades and test scores that will indicate a good chance of graduating from the University of Kansas. The donor also stipulates that the successful candidate shall meet the following criteria: (1) be active in extra-curricular and/or leadership activities, (2) be respectful to parents, teachers, and others in authority, and (3) exhibit good organizational skills and the ability to get along with others.
